

Year 7 2026 All-rounder Scholarships



Boys and girls will be required to sit the academic testing and demonstrate an ability to apply themselves to the academic rigour of the classroom.

Students will be chosen for interview based on their portfolio. Students who are not successful in being offered a scholarship interview may be offered a main round interview (full fee).

CHECKLIST FOR APPLICANTS

- ✓ Submit the Scholarship Application Form via the School's website
- ✓ Candidate NAPLAN scores should demonstrate achievement of Strong in a minimum of 3 categories (which would include Numeracy and Writing)
- ✓ School Reports (showing B average or higher)
- ✓ All supporting documents from Year 3 or higher (do not submit documents that are under Year 3)
- ✓ Reference/s from a provider/s in your chosen field/s (eg Coach, Current Teacher, Scout Leader etc)
- ✓ General school leadership is highly considered
- ✓ Applications close Friday 14 February 2025 at 4pm
