Due to the incumbent taking on the role of Head of Teaching and Learning in the near future, the Headmaster seeks to appoint an appropriately qualified and experienced Christian educator to this full-time permanent leadership position. The successful candidate will join and lead the highly professional, dynamic, industrious Mathematics Faculty. The successful applicant must demonstrate a deep understanding of the syllabus documents across all secondary stages.

The staff of Macarthur are beneficiaries of an Apple laptop computer (for the duration of employment), a supportive Christian teaching environment and well-resourced facilities within the Beavis Mathematics Rooms. This building is part of the Integrated Studies Precinct, containing the teaching spaces for the Faculty of Mathematics, the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Technology and Creative Design.

Candidates for this role will be required to demonstrate:

- an ability to lead staff in pedagogical and professional learning and improvement;
- strong communication, organisational and professional standards;
- a passion for teaching and a deep knowledge of the syllabus content, including the recent revisions to the syllabus;
- a passion for Mathematics and how it integrates with other subjects;
- an innovative approach to teaching and learning including classroom differentiation; and,
- a commitment to detailed and timely feedback to students and a deep understanding of how students think and learn.

The successful candidate must also demonstrate innovative use of ICT in teaching and learning, proficiency in writing teaching programmes, and an understanding of best practices in student assessment and feedback. The desire to contribute to the outdoor education camping and co-curricular programmes is imperative.
