Fees

Parents are billed annually in January via email. Parents may choose a payment plan as outlined on the EasyPay payment form. All account balances must be finalised by the end of the calendar year to ensure that the enrolment is maintained.

Any additional fees incurred due to co-curricular or extra-curricular activities will be billed to the student account. Payment arrangements for these events will be advised by the coordinating teacher. (See Additional Costs below).

The School maintains the right to refuse a student participating in a co-curricular activity if the tuition account is not paid up to date at the time of registration for that activity.

All year groups (including Transition) follow school terms. The dates for each term are advertised on the School website.

Sibling Discount

Sibling discounts apply as follows

First Sibling 10%
Second Sibling 25%
Third and subsequent siblings 50%

The above discounts apply to students attending the School concurrently from the same family/ household.

Student Activity Levy

The Student Activity Levy covers most of the costs incurred in providing educational programmes including the initial cost of stationery, school diary, School Yearbook, sport entry and transport fees, textbook hire, excursions and outdoor education camp costs. The levy includes an amount for the provision of an electronic device to students, either as a take-home device or for in-class use depending on the age of the student.

Years 5 and 6 attend an additional overnight camp to Canberra/ Bathurst annually. The fee for this trip is included in the Student Activity Levy.

Device Options

From Year 7 iPads are issued to students and from Year 10 a laptop is issued. These devices are leased on a three year basis after which time the student owns the device. If a student has a device and withdraws prior to the three year lease expiry, the device must be returned to the School or the remaining payout figure must be finalised.

Additional Costs

The only additional costs for parents generally include extra-curricular overnight activities such as the Snowsports Programme, Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme expeditions, Queensland Outreach, International Study Tours and other overnight excursions that are offered from time to time.

Building Fund

The School Building Fund is a voluntary donation to the School to support the development of the future Masterplan and development of the School. Donations to this fund over \$2 are tax deductible. https://www.macarthur.nsw.edu.au/about-macarthur/facilities/

Capital Contribution Fee

This fee covers the operation, utility, maintenance, debt servicing costs of the current buildings and facilities of the School. Each family pays the Capital Contribution Fee once a year.

Parents and Friends Fee

The Parents and Friends conduct activities that support and seek to further advance the programmes and facilities of Macarthur.

Macarthur Bus Service

Fees apply for the Macarthur operated bus services to students who use the service. The service area is strictly limited and subject to change annually to accommodate the location of students. The fee applies for the whole term/ year and is not refunded if a student does not use the full service (eg if a student only uses the service in the morning, the full fee is applicable)

Alumni

Year 12 students are charged a fee of \$150 to be members of the Macarthur Alumni.
