DISCOVERY PROGRAMME CONDITIONS FOR LESSONS

Commencement Spring Term date/s:

- Week 3 of Spring Term

Fees

- The tuition fee for the Discovery Programme (5 lessons) is **\$125** per student for the programme. Payments are made directly to the tutors. An invoice will be sent home at the commencement of the programme by your child's tutor.
- Tuition fees are payable for the entire term upon receiving an invoice from the tutor. It is recommended payment be made by cheque or directly to tutor bank accounts; cash is NOT to be sent to your child's lesson.

Confirmation of lessons

- Confirmation of lessons and tutor details will be emailed prior to the commencement of lessons with relevant tutor information included.

Practice

- In order to ensure the student reaches their full potential, we recommend the student does 10 minutes practice five days a week. Work out what practice schedule suits your family routine and stick to it. It is always advisable for a parent to sit in on your child's practice as they then have support and an audience!

Outcomes

- Outcomes achieved through the five-week programme will include instrument awareness, development of correct posture, bow hold and use, left hand position on finger board and rhythmic, music literacy and aural awareness.

Equipment and instruments

- The School will provide the tutor book (which has a weekly practice diary included).
- Your child will be provided with an instrument for the programme.
- Harps will be available to rent from the Harp tutor and information will be provided prior to the commencement of lessons.

Recommendation for Peripatetic lessons

- At the conclusion of the programme tutors will give a recommendation for if your child should continue playing. If your child enjoyed their lessons and is keen to continue next year, please let your tutor know.
