COVID-19 Protocols for New Parents and Carers on the First Day of School

Parents and carers of new students will be permitted to enter the designated area on campus for the purpose of dropping off children in Transition, Kindergarten and Year 7, as well as any other new student to the School.

Parents must wear a face mask and sign in using the QR code associated with the Services NSW app. Parents will NOT be permitted into any classrooms.

COVID-19 Protocols for Existing Parents and Other Visitors to the Campus on the first day of School

Consistent with the Public Health Order, non-essential adults are NOT permitted on the campus or at school events other than to drop-off or pick-up children using the designated areas. To avoid traffic congestion please leave the campus promptly after delivering your child to school.

YEAR 12 (Senior School)

Monday 1 February:

Please take particular notice of the arrival and departure times below.

On arrival, Year 12 students will need to find the staff member in the PURPLE vest, they will then be directed to the assembly point. Students will then be introduced to staff that will accompany their Year group to camp.

Luggage must not exceed the maximum weight of 20kg. Please do not pack any unnecessary items.

Also attached to EdSmart Camp slip is a Medication/Asthma Management Plan Form - *If your child will require the administration of medicine while on camp, please print and complete, outlining the details of the medicine to administer. Once the form is completed, place in a zip lock bag (labelled with your child's full name) together with packaged medication. Please hand zip lock bag to the supervising teacher on the morning of departure.*

Monday 8 February:

Students new to Macarthur should present themselves to Reception at the Administration building at 8.00am to meet with their buddies. Consistent with the Public Health Order, non-essential adults are not permitted on the campus or at school events other than to drop-off or pick-up children using the designated areas. To avoid traffic congestion, parents of all students should immediately depart the campus after delivering their child to school.

Normal lessons begin at 8.10am and conclude at 2.40pm each day.

ENTERING, PARKING AND LEAVING THE SCHOOL

On the first day, watch for members of staff who will be wearing coloured safety jackets to receive instructions on where to park or where to drop off your child and baggage if he or she is departing for a camp. **Please deliver your child and leave as soon as possible to ease congestion.**

Please keep the Disabled Parking free.



Finally, the safety of the children moving around the school grounds is of paramount importance.

You are asked to exercise extreme caution at all times when entering, driving on and leaving the school property, in view of the volume of traffic we experience in the morning and the afternoon peak periods.

Please bear in mind that the morning of Day 1 is especially busy because of the older students departing for camps. The speed limit within the school grounds is 20.
